#### **ORDER**

An amount of Rs.15,900/- lakh has been provided in the State Budget 2018-19 for Police Department under Modernisation of Police Department to implement various schemes/activities during 2018-19 under the following Head of Accounts;

- 1) 2055-00-115-98-Modernisation of Police Department Rs.9100 Lakh
- 2) 4055-00-207-92 Modernisation of Police Department Rs.6800 Lakh

Also, an amount of Rs.700 Lakh has been allocated for Gender Specific schemes under the following Head of Accounts;

- 1) 2055-00-001-90- Rs.620 Lakh
- 2) 4055-00-207-93 Rs.80 Lakh

Out of the total amount of **Rs.16900 lakh(15900+700)**, an amount of Rs. **3218 lakh** was included in Green Book, Administrative Sanction was accorded for vide GO(Rt) No.1334/2018/Home on 06.05.2018.

State Police Chief furnished proposals for Special working Group/working Group with a total outlay of **Rs.7612 Lakhs (6912 +700)**. The Working Group meeting held on 14.06.2018 considered the proposals and approved the following proposals as detailed below:

Government have examined the proposal furnished by the State Police Chief and the decisions taken by the Working Group in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for an outlay of Rs.4522 lakhs(Rs forty five crore and twenty two lakh only) in respective Head of Accounts as mentioned above under Modernisation of Police Force(Rs.3822 lakhs) and Flagship Programme on Women Safety & Security (Rs.700 lakhs) as agreed by the Working Group subject to the following conditions.

- 1. A(IV-2): As the Project of implementing video conferencing System in Prison Dept with the Court is in progress, State Police Chief have to consult with DG(P&CS) and steps to be taken to connect all the major offices of Police Department with Prison & the Court.
- 2. A(VII)&(XI) All Purchases must be done in confirmity of the rules/regulations laid down by both Store Purchase Department & E&IT Department where ever it applies to, considering the need & priority.
- 3. B(I-2)State Police Chief shall submit separate proposal to Finance Department.
- 4. The External Agency, if any,committed for implementing any project/activity referred above shall be selected in a transparent procedure and the agency will be an accredited agency approved by Government.
- 5. State Police Chief shall monitor the functioning and utilisation of the scheme for upgradation of Scientific Investigation facilities.

State Police Chief shall ensure that the sanctioned amount to be expended in accordance with the existing rules & regulations.
