#### **ORDER**

The current years Plan Budget provides an outlay of Rs.1030 Lakhs under the scheme Modernisation of Police Department. The outlay provided and the fund earmarked for each component is as follows.

The Director General of Police has furnished detailed proposals in this regard for the consideration of the Working Group. Accordingly the Working Group met on 26-05-2010 considered the proposal of the Director General of Police in detail and decided to accord administrative sanction for the utilization of amount under the plan schemes as detailed below.

# a. REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE WORK OF BARRACKS (Rs.2,40,00,000/)

The objective of the scheme is to undertake repair and maintenance work of 14 selected barracks, by incurring a total expenditure of Rs: 2,40,00,000/- as detailed below.

# d. INTERNAL ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS (RS. 150 LAKHS)

The Objective of the scheme is to improve citizen service delivery by making an integrated system to modernize the internal administrative process. It involves two components viz software development and development of along with computer and accessories for ensuring administrative office connectivity throughout the State and secondly making up of a consolidated and integrated data base of all Police Personnel. The software development is to be undertaken through NIC/IT Mission/C-DAC. Inspector General of Police, SCRB will be the implementing officer. Estimated Expenditure is as follows:-
